In Board of Aldermen, Jan 13. 1886.

Ordered,

That the Superintendent of Streets, be authorized, under the direction of the Joint Standing Committee on Roads and Bridges, to pave main street, from Pelham to Moore streets, with Granite blocks, also, to set Edge-stones on the southerly side of said main street between said Pelham and Moore streets, the said Edge-stones to be set under the provisions of Chap. 191 of the Acts of 1863, authorizing assessments to be laid for materials furnished in such setting.
