Re: Subcommittee Report-Six Month Study of Items Requested by  
License Commissioners Following Taxi Meter Rates Increase and  
Related Issues- VOTE OF LICENSE COMMISSION-OCTOBER 29, 1998

The following items were voted on 3-0 on October 29, 1998 by the  
License Commission after discussion and hearings held on October  
27, 1998.

### 1) Increase in Medallions

The Commission has voted to send this item back to the committee  
for further study following the implementation of the new computer  
system at the radio services. A review of the radio computer  
systems should take place over the next months and then further  
consideration should be given to the idea of more medallions.

The Commission felt that new technology could effect the new  
medallions. One radio service and possibly more are adding a  
computer monitoring system which tracks the cabs on each stand and  
relays the calls without dispatcher discretion. This new system  
may reduce short fare complaints and make each radio service more  
accountable.

The Commission did however, vote to increase the number of  
accessible medallions by three. The same process as was used two  
years ago will be followed to issue these three new accessible  
medallions. The selected candidates shall follow the rules as  
established two years ago and shall have these vans on the road by  
not later than December 31, 1999, or loose all rights to such  
medallion(s).
