- WHEREAS: The City Council has received petitions from the Franklin, Green, Bay, Hancock Street Area regarding the danger of speeding cars; and
- WHEREAS: This fear and complaint is echoed in many residential streets in all parts of the City, particularly long through streets; therefore, be it
- ORDERED: That the City Manager review with the Traffic Department and Police Department the speed limits on the above-mentioned streets along with that on all long streets to assess whether we should go into the State, where necessary, to request a wholesale reduction in speed limits on such streets; and be it further
- ORDERED: That the issue of speed bumps be thoroughly discussed and reviewed; and be it further
- ORDERED: That the City Manager report to the Council on what actions can be taken to relieve the danger.
