Thank you for promptly apprising me of Councillor Wylie's City Council Order of April 22, 1974.

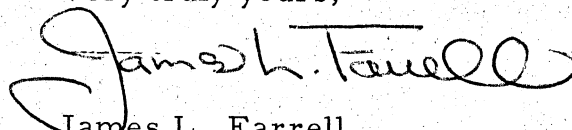
In reply to your inquiry, I have forwarded some of the relevant legislation and proposed legislation which exists now, i. e. the Model Municipal Sign By-Law proposed by the Conservation Law Foundation for the Outdoor Advertising Board of the Commonwealth, to certain staff of the Planning Department.

The staff has been directed by me to draft a sign control ordinance for ultimate consideration by the Council taking into account the Council order.

I have further directed staff to coordinate their work with Mr. Charles F. Sprague of the Building Department and with Edward McCarthy, Acting City Solicitor.

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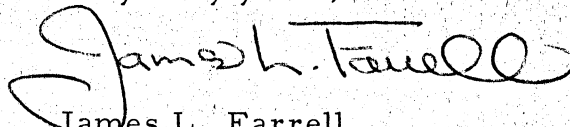
