To the Honorable, the City Council:

In response to Council Order #3 of June 4, 1990 and Awaiting Report #55 of July 30, 1990 regarding enforcement of the "No Parking" restriction at the bus stop on Magazine Street between William and Auburn Streets, please be advised of the following:

Traffic Director George Teso reports that beginning June 7, 1990, the Traffic Department stepped up enforcement of this area and found that there were many vehicles parking at this bus stop. Since that time, the Department's record show a decrease in the number of vehicles parked (and tagged) in this bus stop. A check of the first 15 days in August revealed that four vehicles were seen in this bus stop and all were tagged. The Department will continue its monitoring and enforcement of this area.

Police Chief Anthony Paolillo reports that the Police Department has also intensified its enforcement of this area; Officer Yvonne Hall of the Traffic Division has been specifically assigned to enforce this area.
