I, Warren R. McManus, do solemnly swear that I will support the Constitution of the United States of America.





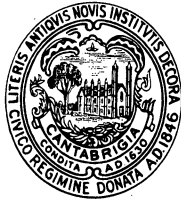
