To the Honorable, the City Council:

In response to the order introduced by Councilor Vellucci requesting that I submit a written explanation to all members of the Water Department Union and the City Council as to the meaning and significance of a requested transfer in the amount of \$6,000.00 in Agenda Item No. 10 of December 11, 1972, to F-18, entitled "Clothing Allowance", please be advised that this appropriation is necessary in order that I might afford to the comparable working employees of the Water Department a \$3.50 weekly clothing consideration as is currently being practiced in the Department of Public Works.

In other words it is my intention to treat the employees of the Water Department in the comparable light to those of the Public Works Department as far as "clothing allowance" goes.

I have agreed with the members of the Water Department Union that this consideration will extend back to July 1, 1972. In other words the employees of the Water Department who will be receiving this allowance will receive it retroactive to July 1st of this year.

I would hope that your Honorable Body would look with favor on this transfer in order that this contractual obligation might be satisfied.
