- WHEREAS: There has been a great deal of "talk" about relocating the home of the Boston Celtics; and
- WHEREAS: There is one large dusty vacant lot of land in Cambridge called "Cambridge Center", better known as Kendall Square; and
- WHEREAS: There does not appear to be any solution in the immediate future for the site on the north of Broadway, where TRW was supposed to relocate; therefore be it
- ORDERED: That the City Manager request the Cambridge Redevelopment Authority to consider the possibility of relocating the Celtics in Kendall Square; and be it further
- ORDERED: That Mr. Harry Mangurian be contacted; and be it further
- ORDERED: That the City Manager report back in two weeks.
