Resolution that an apportionment of the \$500,000,000 of the state revenue surplus be used for future water and sewer assessments imposed to 60 cities and towns by the Massachusetts Water Resources Authority.

RESOLVED, that as a \$500,000,000 state operation surplus is realized, the Town Council of the City Known as the Town of Watertown, request our Town Manager to actively seek out an apportionment of such state revenue surplus as it relates to Watertown's future assessments for water and sewer imposed by the Massachusetts Water Resources Authority.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all the 60 cities and towns that are comprised of the MDC water and sewer district be notified of the vote taken by the Watertown Town Council, also to be furnished to the Governor of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, Secretary of Administration and Finance, Speaker George Keverian of the House, Senate President William Bulger, Commissioner Geary of the MDC, Senator Bachrach, Representative Ciccarelli and the Massachusetts Water Resources Authority, for the intended purpose of demonstrating our displeasure in the funding mechanism implemented for a resource authority program.
