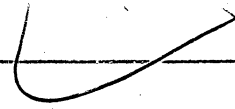

NICU Mom Runs Marathon

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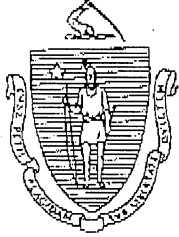
Terry Ward, mother of NICU graduate, **Tommy Ward**, completed this year's Boston Marathon and raised over \$6,000 in donations for the BI-Deaconess Newborn Services Fund. Tommy, who was born at 27 weeks on Christmas Day in 1997, weighed 1 lb. 15 oz. and required a 3-month stay. Today, Tommy is a happy, healthy little boy. Mrs. Ward states "the last two years have been an incredible and joyous journey watching Tommy grow from a newborn to an active, happy, adorable toddler. He received tremendous care and love from so many people in the NICU who helped him learn to breathe, eat and grow."

The Newborn Services Fund provides educational materials and support for families during the enormously challenging experience of having a critically ill infant in the NICU.

Group B Streptococcus Antigen Detection in Neonates

For a number of years, the BIDMC Department of Pathology's Division of Microbiology has offered detection of group B streptococcus antigen in blood, CSF and urine of neonates by a latex agglutination test. Data published within the last five years point to the fact that this test lacks both sensitivity and specificity and
