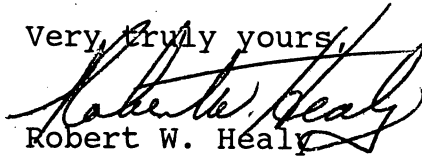

I am hereby requesting the appropriation of \$20,000.00 in the Grant Fund of the Department of Human Services Salary and Wages Account (\$16,800.00), Other Ordinary Maintenance Account (\$3,200.00) from the Boston Foundation.
