Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1. When applying the criteria for abatement eligibility under M.G.L., C. 59, Section 5, Clause Forty-first C, the City of Cambridge is hereby authorized to exempt the income producing assets of an elderly person from the calculation of the minimum income requirements thereunder, so long as the qualifying amount of gross receipts is otherwise met under the terms of the said State Statute.
