In Common Council, Apr. 22 1861-

Ordered,

That the Committee on Roads and Bridges be instructed to consider and report upon the expediency of laying a course of block stone <sup>the proper</sup> distance between the Railroad tracks and the edge-stone for the wheels of carriages to run upon, in such paved streets as have not now such a course of block stone.
