That the Mayor as Chairman of the School Committee be and hereby is requested to seek the co-operation of his colleagues, the Honorable Members of the School Committee, in making, before the next meeting of the School Committee, the necessary preparations to enable all the public school students of Cambridge to hold suitable and appropriate ceremonies in each and every one of the City's public schools to commemorate on Thursday, April 4th, the death of Dr. King, since the schools will be closed on the actual anniversary date.
