- WHEREAS: This City Council was deeply saddened upon learning of the death of Reverend Albert Edward Good, a Maryknoll missionary priest and former Cantabrigian; and
- WHEREAS: Reverend Good was born in Cambridge on June 19, 1913, attended local schools, and on June 16, 1940 was ordained a Maryknoll priest and from 1942 until 1946 served as rector of the minor Maryknoll seminary in St. Louis, Missouri; and
- WHEREAS: Reverend Good served fourteen years in the Maryknoll African mission in Musoma, Tanzania from 1946 to 1960; and
- WHEREAS: Reverend Good was the brother of retired associate Superior Court Justice Francis John Good and Catherine and Mary Good, as well as the sister of Sister Miriam Catherine Good, MM, also a Maryknoll missionary; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its deepest sympathy to the Good family at this time of such personal loss; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to the Good family on behalf of the entire City Council.
