MAYOR WOLF

- WHEREAS: It has come to the attention of this City Council that the United States Post Office is creating a large postal facility, including a truck terminal, in Waltham just across route 128 from the Cambridge Reservoir; and
- WHEREAS: This terminal could have significant impact on the reservoir; and
- WHEREAS: The site has already been proven to be contaminated requiring a careful cleanup; and
- WHEREAS: Members of the Lexington Conservation Commission have expressed concern about this facility's environmental impact; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to ask the Water Board and the Conservation Commission to review the plans for the Post Office terminal in Waltham at the corner of Trapelo Road, route 128, and Smith Street, including the contamination cleanup; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Manager be requested to take whatever action is appropriate to protect the Cambridge water supply and to report back to the City Council when this situation has been reviewed as to what action, if any, the City council should take.
