RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to the Hillis family on behalf of the entire City Council.

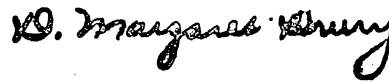

WHEREAS: This City Council was deeply saddened at learning of the death of Patricia "Patti Anri" Hillis on August 14, 2003; and

WHEREAS: Patricia was the cherished daughter of Robert D. Hillis and Mary E. Hillis, and of the late Patricia Hobson Hillis; and

WHEREAS: Patricia's passing will leave a void in the lives of all her surviving family, her sister Catherine Gover and her husband Girard, and her brothers David Hillis and his wife Micky, Dean Hillis and his wife Nicole, James J. and Robert G. Hillis, her dear little friend Maureen Ferriera, and many friends at the Fernald Development Center; and

WHEREAS: Patricia was born at the height of the rubella epidemic in 1964, which left her multiply handicapped and medically fragile, and the prognosis was that she would not live beyond the age of 12; she defied expectations by living to be nearly thirty-nine; and

WHEREAS: Patricia lived most of her life at the Fernald Developmental Center and became the subject of print and TV news stories about the efforts to keep state developmental centers open, including a documentary about the Fernald Developmental Center to be released next year; and
