The petitioner, American Teletronics Long Distance, Inc., is required to give notice by publications hereof once, in the Boston Globe, the Morning Union (Springfield), the Berkshire Eagle (Pittsfield) and the Worcester Telegram, and to serve a copy hereof at least twenty-one (21) days prior to said date [January 28, 1993], on the attached list, and to make return of service and publication no later than January 28, 1993.
