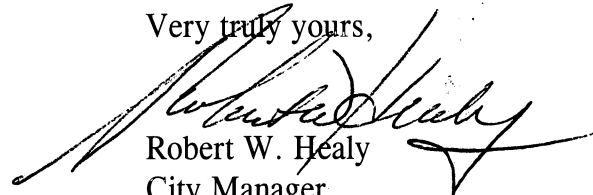

I am hereby requesting the appropriation of \$79,795 in the grant fund of the Human Services Salary & Wages Account (\$69,510), and the Other Ordinary Maintenance Account (\$10,285) from the Massachusetts Department of Education. The Massachusetts Department of Education granted these funds as a result of an increase in the state budget for adult basic education for FY98.
