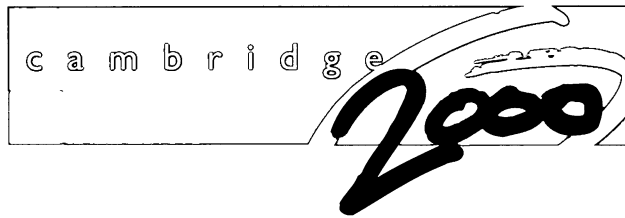

To the Honorable, the City Council:

I recommend that the City Council appropriate \$200,000 in Free Cash to the Public Investment Fund Community Development Department Extraordinary Expenditures Account for the first phase of the Eastern Cambridge Planning Study. The funds will be used to retain a consultant team to carry out a comprehensive planning study of the Eastern Cambridge moratorium area adopted by the Larkin petition. We anticipate that a second phase of the study will be funded with up to an additional \$400,000 in capital funds in FY 2001.

This comprehensive effort will be carried out under the direction of the Community Development Department and with the assistance of an Eastern Cambridge Planning Study Committee, which I will appoint this spring. The study will include, at a minimum, the following components:

- Development of a comprehensive vision for the affected area;
- Assessment of the study area in terms of transportation, land use and zoning, urban design and open space;
- Analysis of and development of guidelines for key undeveloped sites;
- Development of an action plan, including recommendations for neighborhood protection, zoning, transportation, open space, land use and urban.

It is anticipated that this study will take one year to complete and will be finalized in advance of the expiration of the moratorium now in effect.
