

City of Cambridge.

In the year One Thousand Eight Hundred
and Sixty-seven.

An Ordinance.

Establishing the Office of City Engineer and
Surveyor.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the
City of Cambridge, as follows:—

Sec. 1. There shall be chosen annually, in
the month of April, and whenever a vacancy
occurs, by concurrent vote of the City Council, to be
first acted upon by the Mayor and Aldermen,
a City Engineer and Surveyor, who shall be a
resident of Cambridge, and who shall hold his
office until a successor is appointed or he is re-
moved. He shall be removable at the pleasure
of the City Council and shall receive such com-
pensation as the City Council may from time
to time determine.

Sec. 2. The said Engineer and Surveyor, un-
der the direction and control of the Board of
Aldermen, shall have charge of all the plans
of streets, drains, and sewers belonging to the

City. He shall make such surveys, plans, estimates, and descriptions, and take such levels, as may be required of him by the Mayor, the Board of Aldermen, or any Committee of the City Council; and he shall perform all other such services for the City of Cambridge as may be required of him by the Mayor or the Board of Aldermen, or any Committee of the City Council, or the Water Board, or the Commissioners of the Cemetery.

Sec. 3. Said Engineer shall annually, in the month of December, present to the City Council a report in relation to his department, showing the number of persons employed, the detailed expenses of the department, the general nature of the work, the condition of all structures that come under his supervision, that are in process of construction, or that have been completed during the previous year, and such other general information in relation to the same as he may deem expedient.

Sec. 4. The election of a City Engineer and Surveyor for the current year shall take place as soon as may be after the passage of this Ordinance.
