Subject ENFORCEMENT OF RESIDENT PARKING

The Traffic Department will begin to enforce the Resident Parking Regulations around the City Hall, City Hall Annex and 51 Inman Street on October 1, 1976.

I am asking you to inform your employees that unless they have a Resident Sticker on their car they will be subject to a \$15.00 fine.

If any employee whose car is registered in Massachusetts and principally garaged in Cambridge wishes to obtain a Resident Sticker, he or she may do so by bringing their registration to the Third Floor of the City Hall Annex.

There is a fee of \$1.00.
