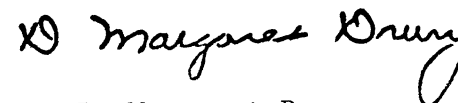

I am hereby requesting the appropriation of \$65,000 to the General Fund Finance Department Assessing Other Ordinary Maintenance Account. The additional appropriation is necessary due to the loss of two employees in the Assessing Office during the year when values had to be certified by the State Department of Revenue.
