We have checked the streets around the Morse School and will reinstall the "School" and "School Crossing" warning signs which were found faded or missing. The enclosed plan, which was taken from the March 84 School Crossing Guard Evaluation Report shows the location of these signs. This plan also shows the location of the crosswalks in the Morse School Area. As soon as the weather warms up, these crosswalks and stop lines will be painted by our contractor. We estimate this will be in early spring and will take about one month to complete the city.
