- WHEREAS: This City Council was deeply saddened upon learning of the death of Henry "Clate" Haley, former Assistant Director of Audio Visual Education in the Cambridge School Department; and
- WHEREAS: "Clate", as he was referred to by so many of his friends, was a life-long Cantabrigian who attended local schools and graduated from Boston College with a Bachelor of Arts Degree in 1926; and
- WHEREAS: Clate was first appointed to the School Department on June 24, 1929 as an instructor in the Audio Visual Department, serving in that capacity until January 1, 1954 when he was promoted to Assistant Director, the position from which he retired on June 30, 1972; and
- WHEREAS: Clate was admired by his colleagues in the School Department as well as by his many students for his kindness and dedication to teaching, as well as for his keen ability to find time to engage in his favorite pastime, that of a "political analyst"; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its deepest sympathy to Mrs. Lucy Haley and her family at this time of personal sorrow; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Mrs. Haley on behalf of the entire City Council.
