Attached is an order requesting the appropriation of \$120,000.00 in the grant fund from the Commonwealth of Massachusetts to the Human Services Salary & Wages Account \$73,729, Other Ordinary Maintenance Account \$45,571 and Travel & Training Account \$700. The grant is a renewal of the State's Housing Search Program now called the Homeless Intercept Program. The funds are used to prevent homelessness by providing counseling for tenants and landlords, mediation for landlord/tenant disputes and housing search assistance for families facing eviction.
