WHEREAS: A special event will take place in Cambridgeport on Saturday, June 24, 1995 that is one of many positive outcomes of the Cambridgeport rezoning effort which was concluded in 1992; and

WHEREAS: "Clean and Green at 82 Pacific Street - A Community Celebration" is the name given to the event that celebrates the beginning of a new public park; and

WHEREAS: This occasion marks the transformation of a paved, truck parking lot, into a large green open space to be used as a play area by Cambridge children; and

WHEREAS: This event is the culmination of a **community gathering**, in the truest sense of the phrase, that included Cambridgeport residents, Cambridge City employees, members of the Cambridge City Council, Massachusetts Institute of Technology staff, and area business and property owners; and

WHEREAS: MIT donated nearly one and a half acres of land in exchange for the transfer of development rights; and

WHEREAS: MIT "cleaned" the land, by removing the pavement and more than three feet of soil, replacing it with clean seeded soil, that has grown into a lush green grass; and

WHEREAS: The City of Cambridge installed an irrigation system to sustain the grass, built a perimeter fence, and constructed new sidewalks and curbs around this site; and

WHEREAS: A beautiful result such as this new green space is truly a cause for celebration; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That this City Council does hereby extend its congratulations and thanks to all those involved in the Cambridgeport rezoning process for their hard work and achievements, and MIT for the donation and preparation of the "Clean and Green" open space at 82 Pacific Street.
