Drive.

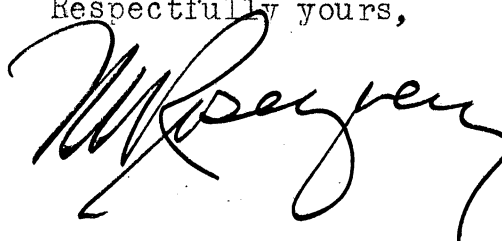
I made an application for the erection
