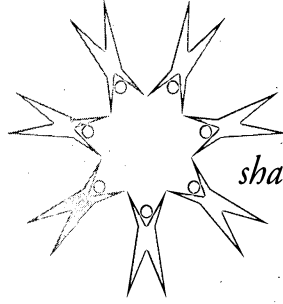

WHEREAS: The School Committee recently attended a dinner at Lesley College where they were entertained by President Margaret McKenna and her staff; and

WHEREAS: Many ideas around continued assistance to our public schools were discussed; and

WHEREAS: Lesley has over the years been a leader in innovative programming in collaboration with our school system, such as the Compass Summer Program, Reading Recovery; Student/Teacher Placement, Student Interns, Pathways, Literacy Project, Project Promise and many more; and

WHEREAS: Lesley will be awarding a \$5000 scholarship for Cambridge residents which is in addition to many other opportunities for advanced education for our students, and

WHEREAS: Lesley should be commended for its concern for the educational needs of our city, and

WHEREAS: Lesley is experiencing difficulty in meeting one of its own needs, namely finding an athletic field for its Soccer and Soft Ball teams; and

WHEREAS: Our athletic fields are, at present, fully utilized; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to direct the Director of Recreation to meet with officials of Lesley college to determine what we can do to help them solve their dilemma, and report back to the City Council.

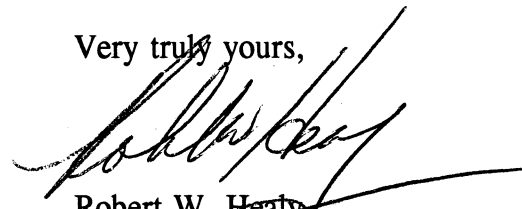
