Council Order Regarding Assistance to
Youth Hockey

In response to your inquiry, please be advised that the Recreation Department allows each of the four Little Leagues one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) to be used toward officials; the Pop Warner Football League \$500.00 to be used toward officials; the Babe Ruth Baseball \$1,000.00 to be used toward officials. Furthermore, the Recreation Department expended during the winter of 1972 and 1973 in excess of five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00) for ice time at the MDC Gore Street Rink for youngsters participating in the Recreation Department Hockey Program. The Recreation Department has not allocated any specific monies for Cambridge Youth Hockey; however, there have been a few occasions when Cambridge Youth Hockey has been able to benefit from ice time granted to the Recreation Department.

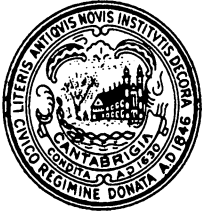
I hasten to add that the Recreation Department has requested a total of twenty-five (25) hours ice time from the MDC at the Gore Street Rink during the winter of 1973 and 1974. If approved, it is intended to allocate approximately twelve (12) hours per week ice time to the Cambridge Youth Hockey. This would commence the first week in November, and I have been advised by the MDC that it may be possible to have a couple of hours each week during October of 1973 which would be used for the benefit of Cambridge Youth Hockey.

The MDC plans to open the Gore Street Rink on Saturday, October 6. As you may know, ice time costs \$25.00

per hour; therefore, this total assistance would amount to \$6,600.00 to Cambridge Youth Hockey, subject, of course, to approval of the ice time by the MDC.
