That the Commissioner of Public Works be and hereby is authorized to grant a permit to Out of Town Newspapers Inc. for the erection of a wooden frame structure thirty-two feet long, twelve feet wide and nine feet high for the purpose of altering the present newspaper stand on the sidewalk surrounding kiosk at Harvard Square.

Provided that, before erecting the above named structure, the petitioner shall obtain a permit from the Building Department and file with the City Clerk a satisfactory bond in the sum of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) conditioned to save harmless the City of Cambridge from all claims for damages arising from the construction, maintenance and use of said structure.
