That this City Council feels that an emergency exists in Newtowne Court, Jefferson Park, Washington Elms, Miller River, Truman Apartments, Daniel F. Burns Apartments and Jackson Gardens in regards to the security needs of these housing developments; and be it further

ORDERED:

That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to appropriate a sum sufficient to provide for the security of these apartments up to \$250,000.00; and be it further

ORDERED:

That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to confer with the members of the Housing Authority and the Tenant Senate prior to submitting this appropriation request and to give this Council a report within one week; and be it further

ORDERED:

That the City Solicitor be and hereby is requested to submit a legal opinion to the Council as to whether or not the Mayor and the City Council can declare a "State of Emergency" to the lives and safety of all citizens of Cambridge.
