MAY 11, 1987

- WHEREAS: Many people swim regularly for health and exercise; and
- WHEREAS: The locally available swimming pools, such as the War Memorial and those at the YWCA and YMCA, have closed for cleaning in the same two weeks in recent years; and
- WHEREAS: That leaves swimmers without their place to swim; therefore be it
- ORDERED: That the City Manager request the Recreation Director to try to coordinate the City pool with others, so that one remains open at all times, and that some reciprocal agreement for those weeks be made for swimmers; and be it further
- ORDERED: That the City Manager be requested to report the results of these negotiations to the City Council.
