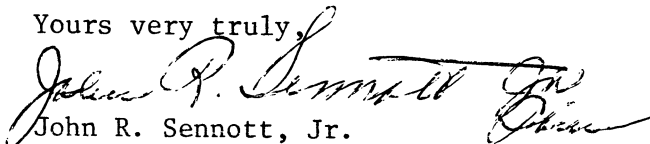
Re: Liquor License Transfer - 10-12 Brookline Street.
