Ordered,

That the Superintendent of Streets be, and hereby is, authorized under the direction of the Joint Standing Committee on Roads and Bridges, to employ such labor as may be necessary to carry on the work of the Street department, during the current year, the expense thereof to be charged to the proper appropriation, and the same to be within the amount specifically authorized upon such appropriation.

The Superintendent of Streets is further authorized to employ the before-mentioned labor without advertising or receiving proposals therefor.
