In accordance with Section 46 of Chapter 92 of the General Laws, as amended by Chapter 390 of the Acts of 1924, I transmit herewith a copy of the order of the Metropolitan District Commission of August 27, 1987, granting to the Cambridge Electric Light Company location for approximately 1550 feet of 115kv transmission line with the necessary wires, cables or pipes in Fresh Pond Parkway and Alewife Brook Parkway, Cambridge, Massachusetts, petitioned for by said Company on July 21, 1987.

Said Section requires that said order shall be deposited in your office on or before September 9, 1987.

ORDERED that, on petition of the Cambridge Electric Light Company dated July 21, 1987, for location shown on plans filed with the Commission, for approximately 1550 feet of 115kv transmission line with the necessary wires, cables, or pipes over portions of Fresh Pond Parkway and Alewife Brook Parkway, Cambridge, Massachusetts, for the transmission of electricity, said location having been found by order of the Department of Public Utilities to be required by public convenience and necessity, said plans and petition being on file in the office of this Commission, a public hearing on said petition having been given by this Commission on Thursday, August 27, 1987, at 10:30 A.M., in room 206 of the Commission in Boston, of which hearing due notice was given to all persons interested of the time and place by publishing a copy of said petition and the order of notice issued thereon by this Commission in newspapers published in the City of Cambridge, being the City in which the location petitioned for would lie, the first publication having been made at least fourteen days prior to the date of said hearing, and it appearing, in the opinion of this Commission, that public convenience and necessity so require, said Cambridge Electric Light Company is hereby granted a location for said transmission line, wires, cables or pipes, in said Fresh Pond Parkway and Alewife Brook Parkway in Cambridge, Mass., to the extent and upon the terms, conditions, and obligations hereinafter specified, the same being such as the public necessity and a due regard for the rights of the Commonwealth require, namely:-

1. The Cambridge Electric Light Company shall conform to all provisions of law applicable to the exercise of the rights and performance of the work under this grant and to the rules and regulations of the Metropolitan District Commission.
2. The Cambridge Electric Light Company shall do the work of installing said transmission line, wires, cables or pipes, in the location hereby granted subject to the approval of the Director of Permits for the Commission, as to time, manner, and location, and in all other respects.
3. The Cambridge Electric Light Company shall indemnify and save harmless the Commonwealth of Massachusetts and the Metropolitan District Commission from any damage it or they may sustain or be required to pay arising out of the exercise by said Company or any of its employees in connection with the work done hereunder.

4. The Cambridge Electric Light Company shall protect and maintain all trees, drainage, or water pipes, and all appurtenances or structures either above or below the surface of the ground over which this location lies, during and upon completion of the work shall restore the surface of the ground to a condition satisfactory to said Director of Permits, for the Commission.
5. The Cambridge Electric Light Company shall take all possible measures during construction to reduce the impact on the area.
6. The Cambridge Electric Light Company shall place and maintain proper barriers at all times and from the beginning of twilight through the whole of every night sufficient lights to protect the public from injury or damage during the progress of the work under this grant or during repairs upon said transmission line, wires, cables or pipes, and work on the location which may hereafter become necessary.
6. The Cambridge Electric Light Company to pay a one-time fee of \$2,325.00.
7. No work shall be done under this grant without first obtaining a permit therefor from said Director of Parks Engineering and Construction, and subject to conditions imposed by him.
