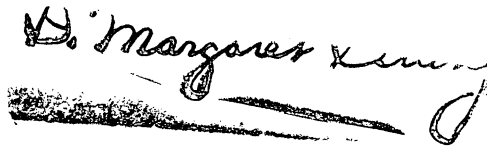

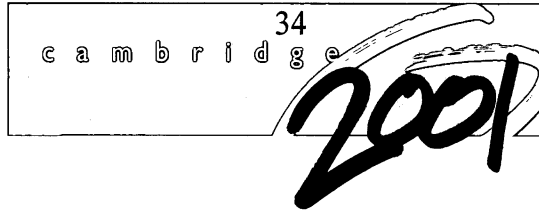

One result of the security analysis that we have been involved in since September 11th is the identification of additional equipment needs for the Special Response Team of the Cambridge Police Department. Therefore, I am recommending the transfer of \$35,500 from the Reserve Fund to the Police Department Other Ordinary Maintenance Account.

This equipment is to provide for officer protection in the event of the need of a "special response" to unforeseen incidents.
