- RESOLVED: That it is the sense of the City Council that the License Commission and the Inspectional Services Commissioner refrain from issuing any and all permits for entertainment, liquor or food to any establishments in the Hampshire Street - Cardinal Medeiros Avenue area; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is instructed to transmit forthwith the intent of this resolution to the License Commission and the Inspectional Services Commissioner.
