Petition of Cambridge Electric Light Company for authority to issue 10,000 additional shares of common capital stock having a par value of \$25 a share and to sell said stock at a price of \$150.00 a share, the proceeds to be used for the purpose of paying long term notes owing to The First National Bank of Boston, in the aggregate amount of \$1,500,000.

Upon the foregoing petition the Department of Public Utilities will hold a public hearing at its hearing room, 166 State House, Boston, on Wednesday the 27th day of June, 1951 at 10:00 o'clock in the forenoon.

And the petitioner is required to give notice of said hearing by publication hereof once at least 7 days prior to said date in the Cambridge Chronicle and Sun and to serve a copy hereof by registered mail at least 7 days prior to said date on the Mayor and City Clerk of Cambridge and the Chairman of the Board of Selectmen and Town Clerk of Town of Belmont, and to make return of service and publication at the time of hearing.
