Dear Cambridge City Councillors:

In accordance with Section 99 of Chapter 43 of the Massachusetts General laws, I, Jack, a professional problem solver a.k.a. George F. Welch Jr. demand a final vote on payment to me of my Bill submitted to the City Council on June 11, 1990 as herein amended to read: "In addition I expect to receive from the city $6.66\% \times 3$ of the gross amount of the \$500 per day that the city ^{is entitled to} recovers from Continental Cablevision ~~on the~~ ^{day of} recovery and $6.66\% \times 3$ of the gross amount of any other monies owed to the city as a result of other acts of non compliance with the Cable Licence by the Transfer Licensee, Continental or the former licensee, "American" that I may discover"

Because the city manager is not empowered under section 99 of chapter 43 to decide this matter, but is responsible for this debt by his refusal to promptly act on my requests of April 17, 1991 and April 24, 1991, it will be up to you, the members of the Cambridge City Council to decide to pay or be sued for violations of the Racketeer Influence Corrupt Organizations Act.
