IN CITY COUNCIL.

April 3, 1917.

Ordered, that the sum of Thirty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$35,000) be and the same hereby is appropriated for the purpose of constructing a separate system of drainage for surface or storm water, as authorized by Chapter 383 Acts of 1903; said debt shall be met by a loan outside the debt limit as authorized in Section 3 of said Chapter 383, and it is further ordered, that a City Debt be created for the sum of Thirty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$35,000) for the purpose of constructing a separate system of drainage for surface or storm water, as authorized by Chapter 383, Acts of 1903; said debt shall be met by a loan outside the debt limit as authorized in Section 3 of said chapter, and from time to time as the City Treasurer may deem necessary bonds of the City will be issued not exceeding that amount, either in the form of registered or coupon bonds, one or both, to be styled Sewer (Separate System) Loan, said bonds to be dated July 1, 1917, and payable \$1,500 each year, 1918 to 1937 both included, and \$500 each year, 1938 to 1947 both included, with interest at the rate of not exceeding 4½ per centum per annum, payable semi-annually; that the Mayor, City Auditor and City Treasurer be and are hereby authorized and instructed to sign and execute said bonds and all transfers and exchanges of the same in the manner directed by the ordinances of the City, and that the City Treasurer be and is hereby directed to bargain and sell, and is hereby authorized to transfer and exchange the same.

(Passed to a second reading at meeting of City Council, held April 3, 1917, and after April 16, 1917, the question will be on adoption.)
