WHEREAS: Forrest L. Gould was a graduate of Rindge Technical High School and Suffolk University Law School prior to being appointed Club House Manager for the Park Department in 1934; and

WHEREAS: Forrest L. Gould was appointed Assistant Clerk of Committees in January of 1947 and soon thereafter assumed the position of Clerk of Committees and City Messenger, a position he held until his retirement in May of 1972; and

WHEREAS: Mr. Gould, as an officer of this City Council served with distinction, pride, and integrity for many years; and

WHEREAS: Mr. Gould passed away after having been hospitalized for a long time after his retirement; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record as naming the room adjacent to the Council Chamber as the "Forrest L. Gould Memorial Room", on behalf of his long record of public service to the City Council; and be it further

RESOLVED: That the administrative Assistant to the City Council make the appropriate arrangements to procure a suitable plaque for this room.
