- WHEREAS: The Cambridgeport community has repeatedly requested to continue to have access to the river for the purpose of launching their boats at the ramp adjacent to Magazine Beach; and
- WHEREAS: Through a previously adopted Council order, the Metropolitan District Commission was requested to establish and maintain such a boat ramp; and
- WHEREAS: It has come to the attention of this City Council, that rather than allowing this kind of access to the river by the community, the M.D.C. has been requested by Northeastern University to allow the University to construct an entire boathouse facility directly between the little league field by Magazine Beach and the pumping station; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record as being opposed to such boathouse facility, which would be in direct opposition to the desires of the Cambridgeport neighborhood particularly, since Northeastern is located in Boston and therefore should not be attempting to utilize open space in Cambridge; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward copies of this resolution to the President of Northeastern University, the Athletic Director of Northeastern University, the Commissioner of the Metropolitan District Commission, Governor Michael S. Dukakis, Senator Michael LoPresti and Senator George Bachrach.
