AN ORDINANCE

In amendment to the General
Ordinances of the City of Cam-
bridge. Be it ordained by the
City Council of the City of Cam-
bridge as follows.—

The General Ordinances of the
City of Cambridge are hereby
amended by adding a new Chap-
ter 28B, entitled "Removal of
Motor Vehicles from Private
Property".

CHAPTER 28B
REMOVAL OF MOTOR
VEHICLES FROM PRIVATE
PROPERTY

A police officer of the rank
of at least sergeant may upon
notification by the owner or
person in control of private prop-
erty that a motor vehicle has
been parked upon said property
without the consent of the own-
er or person in control thereof
and after notice that such park-
ing was prohibited order said
motor vehicle to be towed from
said property to a garage with-
in the City. The registered
owner of the motor vehicle shall
be liable for the cost of towing
and for storage of the motor ve-
hicle at the garage in accordance
with the rates established in the
Traffic Regulations of the City
of Cambridge for the towing of
motor vehicles from public ways.
