WHEREAS: Winter snows will soon be here; and

WHEREAS: Snow-plowing in a automobile lined City like Cambridge is difficult and is always criticized; and

WHEREAS: With a new head of the Department of Public Works, it is hoped that we can get on a new footing with regard to snow-plowing, therefore be it

ORDERED: That the City Manager is hereby requested to have the new D.P.W. head look at the snow-plowing problems and in particular to look at two suggestions:

- (1) On the narrow streets, have residents park on alternate sides, such that one side of the street is plowed one day, then cars move to the other side the next day, and the other side is plowed; and,
- (2) On road, emergency arteries enforce no parking on one side of the street, only and then, after plowing, enforce no parking on the other side; and be it further

ORDERED: That the City Manager is hereby requested to report back to the Council on progress in this matter.
