I am hereby requesting the acceptance of an appropriation of a grant totalling \$68,000 from Attorney General Scott Harshbarger's Office. The City Council, during the FY97 budget process, appropriated \$25,000 leaving a \$43,000 balance, which is now being requested for appropriation in the License Commission (Consumer Council) Salary and Wages Account (\$40,000) and Other Ordinary Maintenance Account (\$3,000)
