Subject City Council Order #5 of April 30, 1979 "Status of Resident Parking Program at the Fresh Pond Reservation"

The Traffic and Parking Department has met with the Water Department and some members of the Water Board concerning the implementation of the Resident Parking Program at the Fresh Pond Reservation. The Traffic Department at these meetings informed the Water Department on the type of signs that must be posted to make this program legal and also that the Traffic Department has no jurisdiction at this reservation and they would have to rely on the Police Department to enforce this restriction.

We have discussed this with Mr. John Seites and he has informed us that he will bring it up at the next Water Board Meeting.

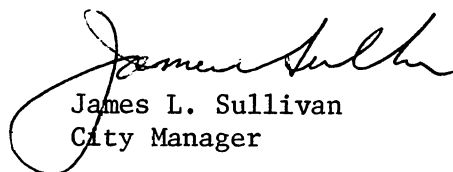
