- WHEREAS: Approximately 15,000 Portuguese and Portuguese Americans live in the Cambridge area who frequently interact with the C.O.P.A. organization and its staff who provide, among other social service programs, such things as an elderly drop-in center; and
- WHEREAS: The Portuguese people of Cambridge should be formally recognized for their outstanding ability to assist one another, regardless of the nature of the help required, a characteristic which all people should possess; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its sincere best wishes to the past and present officers of the Cambridge Organization for Portuguese Americans as they celebrate their fifteenth anniversary and to further extend every good wish for continued success; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to C.O.P.A. on behalf of the entire City Council.

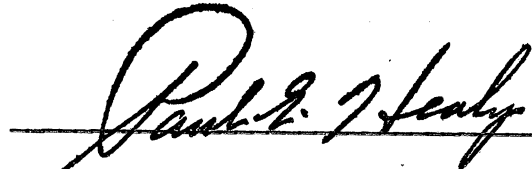
