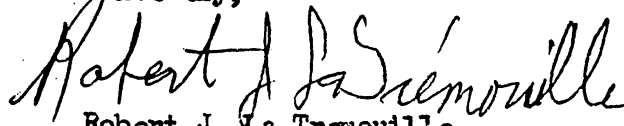

Mr. Sullivan:

On October 31, 1977, you presented a communication to the City Council which apparently vacated existing appointments to the Harvard Square Task Force and replaced them with new members. These, in the majority, include former members of the task force, several of whom had had bad attendance records. It interests me that this effectively removes me without cause from the Task Force. I have not been made aware of Task Force meetings in some time, but I did understand that membership would be reevaluated because of the bad attendance of many members.

I object to this removal without cause. As you are well aware, I was one of the most active and vocal members of the Task force. However, since I did loudly condemn certain proposals of yours, it is rather obvious that I am being removed for purposes of censorship. This makes a farce out of "citizen participation". It also makes a farce out of your claims that the reorganization is for purposes of strengthening the body.

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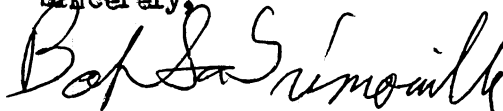
