The City of Cambridge recently sent a home rule petition to the General Court which was signed into law by the Governor and guaranteed elderly tenants protection from eviction because of condominium conversion; and

WHEREAS:

It now appears that the elderly of our City are threatened by the conversion of controlled rental housing units to cooperatives; therefore be it

ORDERED:

That the Cambridge City Council hereby requests the City Solicitor to immediately draw up a home rule petition which would be filed in the General Court giving Cambridge elderly tenants a guarantee that they will not be evicted if their building is converted to cooperatives.
